	*In the past the church used a program called Church Windows which was used used for 8 to 9 years. *Church windows had become dated. *It was required to be installed on all PCs and was not available online. *It was expensive to add a license and we were only using the membership module *We used a separate software for accounting called Sage Peachtree and it was not tailored for church use. *Peachtree and Church windows were not connected so pledging information	
	needed to be pasted into Peachtree manually which would at times cause errors. *At GA a few years ago, Brian met up with the database company Icon. *Icon does a good job of being an all in one software. It combines membership, payroll and accounting. *Icon merges really well with pledges and the accounting piece. *It is cloud based so it can be accessed anywhere. *The cost is \$900 annually for the license and is based on membership size. *This database is now used in Stewardship for reporting etc.
