	*Total Revenues vs Total Expenses shows the expenses are higher *The difference is made up by interfund transfers from endowment funds, designated restriction funds. Money is moved to the operating fund *All transfers are done and are permanent *There is a question on transfers versus loans *SYC keeps all profits and the new agreement is that they can keep up to \$30,000 and above that amount it would be split with the church *SYC does now spend more of their money for upkeep *As of June 30th, we are at a deficit of \$24,000 and at the end of November it is close to \$40,000 *Expecting more income with fund raising activities in December and January with the upcoming auction and holiday appeal *Rev Marian will review with Martha the details of the transfer of funds and get clarification on what has been loaned and what is a permanent transfer. *Carolee will contact Chas to see if there is any statute or policy that addresses a restricted fund that has no activity and there is nobody to contact. "Financial Management Policy Approved by the Coordinating Team: 6/1/2016 Policy Statement in accordance with Board Policy 9–Care for Resources and Financial Controls:

The church shall protect and preserve the financial assets of the church, manage the finances in accordance with the Church Constitution, Board Policy and good accounting practices, and shall provide and maintain reliable reports and records for the Board, the Coordinating Team and the congregation.

#### Section 7 - Fundraising Projects

Fundraising Projects Special fundraising projects related to congregational life should not interfere with established fundraising activities of the church as a whole. Consequently proposals for special fundraising activities should be reviewed by the Coordinating Team, which may consult with the Stewardship Team and Finance Committee as appropriate. Unless an exception is granted by the Coordinating Team, all funds generated by approved fundraising projects will share 20% of the net revenue over \$250 with the Operating Budget."

#### Governance - Stewardship

Our governance policy is silent about stewardship.

- We have no stewardship policy statement in Board Governance.
- There is no governance statement about permission prior to seeking non-stewardship monetary donations from congregants.

This updated policy wording was discussed in November and will be voted on in December after any suggested changes are discussed.

- 9.6 Senior staff is responsible for recruiting and working with the Stewardship team to raise money donated from First UU members and friends in order to allow the congregation of First UU to carry out its mission. The Board is responsible for actively supporting fundraising efforts as set forth by Senior Staff, Coordinating, and Stewardship Teams.
- 9.7 In addition to fundraising by the Stewardship team, there may be occasional requests to the congregation for money. A coordinated approach to fundraising is needed, therefore the Board charges the Coordinating Team with oversight of requests except those generated by the Stewardship Team or directly approved by the Board. Congregants should be informed about the process delineated in Financial Management Policy of the Coordinating Team.

7:50	Vote on Sponsorship for Meg McGuire as Ministerial Fellow Snips from the "Requirements for Ministerial Fellowship with the Unitarian Universalist Association"  Who should decide who is or isn't sponsored? Sponsorship is determined by the congregation's representative body, such as the Board of Trustees. A congregational vote is not required.  What is being said with the decision to sponsor a candidate? At the most basic level, congregational sponsorship indicates confidence in the applicant's potential and suitability for UU ministry. The MFC regards sponsorship as evidence that an applicant is actively committed to the Purposes and Principles of the UUA and the institutions which uphold them. A congregation is not indicating that the applicant is presently ready for ministry when the congregation commits to sponsorship. The final decision to grant fellowship to a candidate is made by the MFC after careful consideration of written materials, evaluations and a personal interview.  In many instances, a congregation will be asked for sponsorship by a person	Carolee
	who is away at school or simply moved away for other reasons. If the person is reasonably well known within the congregation, it is certainly appropriate to consider sponsorship. A congregation may want to recognize an applicant's aspirations through, for example, newsletter articles, announcements, and invitations to participate in congregational activities when the aspirant is in the area. A congregation could invite an aspirant to write a newsletter article sharing with the congregation some of the excitement of their journey. Depending on their interests, resources, and the needs of the aspirant, congregations will choose to support the people they sponsor in a variety of ways. Nothing in particular is required.
