Pandemic Behavior Covenant

First Unitarian Universalist Church of Columbus is continuously striving to be an inclusive community by affirming and embracing our differences. There are cases, however, where cherishing the safety and health of the congregation must be given priority over the privileges of an individual. The COVID-19 pandemic is most certainly one of those cases. The central theme of this covenant revolves around respect for ourselves, for others, and for the spaces we occupy together.

In an effort to best ensure that our community remains a safe and healthy one, as the church reopens, I covenant to do the following:

- Attempt to understand the shifts in standards, expectations, and norms necessitated by the COVID-19 pandemic;
- Accept that these shifts are based on science and reliable public health information and are used to drive all decisions;
- Acknowledge that as knowledge is ever-evolving, these standards, expectations, and norms will also evolve;
- Recognize that as a part of the interdependent web taking risks and protective actions affect each and every person with whom I share time and space while at our church;
- Assume the best intentions of other members of the First UU community, remembering we are all humans collectively experiencing unprecedented times.

I therefore covenant to honor my fellow congregants and staff and treat them with respect. If conflict arises that cannot be resolved privately I promise to seek resolution by mediation with use of First UU's Healthy Relations Policy by notifying a minister.
